Member's Guide

Membership:

Any person 55+ or a spouse of a current member may become a Member.

Members are welcome to participate in all club activities, as well as benefit from any discounts arranged by the Club, including lift ticket discounts at selected hills in Atlantic Canada and Quebec. See the SASC website for details.

Members 60+ (by the end of the current ski season) may purchase our SASCPass. The SASCPass offers unlimited skiing at the following hills: Sugarloaf Park, Poley Mountain, Ben Eoin, Cape Smokey, Martock, Wentworth, and Mark Arendz Provincial Ski Park at Brookvale in PEI.



At the Hill... Getting your lift ticket:

When you join our club, you will receive a membership card with your membership number on it. If you purchased our SASCPass, your 5 digit membership number will be printed in **RED** on the front, with the same number on the back as a barcode



It should be noted that the **SASCPass is NOT** a lift ticket! SASCPass holders visiting a participating ski hill to ski must check-in and sign the SASC Ski Day Register at the hill and record your SASCPass number to get a lift ticket for the day. Some hills are using a digital register which allows you to check in more quickly using the barcode on the back of your card. You may be required to show proof of your membership and Photo ID when checking in.

Ski Trips:

Each year the club organizes two "extended trips", typically to Quebec and New England. These usually comprise of 4 or 5 days of skiing as well as 5 nights ski-in-ski out accommodations and meals. There is also often a shorter trip to the Gaspé region of Quebec at the end of the ski season



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Refund Policy:

The SASCPass fee will be refunded in the event that injury or illness prevents the member from skiing. The request for a refund must be in writing outlining the circumstances, enclosing the membership card and be mailed to the Registrar. If the member's request is received by January 15th, the refund will be 100% of the SASCPass less the number of days skied, at the previous year's rate. If received before February 15th, the refund will be 50% less the number of days skied. No refunds will be issued for request after February 15th.

Hill Directors:

Each major participating ski hill has a SASC Hill Director who maintains and verifies the registration book, arranges ski lessons, organizes the Kell Antoft Day / Social gatherings, and keeps members informed of such events via bulletin boards / Social Media.

Kell Antoft Days:

At each of the major participating hills, the Club hosts an annual celebration of our founder – Kell Antoft. This day consists of skiing, lessons, lunch, and social.



Member Ski Lessons:

Several of the participating hills offer free weekly lessons to SASC members. This offer varies from year to year.

Annual Ski Pass Pricing / Payout to the Hills:

Each year the Early Bird and Regular SASCPass rates are established as the weighted average of the corresponding Early Bird and Regular rates at each of the participating hills. Each participating hill receives its share based on the number of skied days at their hill. Therefore the more you ski the more your ski hill earns!!!



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
